VIII. INFORMATION ON THE NATIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION SYSTEM

8.1 Description of the National System of Higher Education of the Kyrgyz Republic

The Kyrgyz Higher Education system consists of the following High Institutions:

1. The Universities, which:

- implement programmes of higher education, undergraduate and postgraduate, in different fields;
- carry out fundamental and applied research on a wide range of issues;
- prepare, train, retrain and ensure professional development, and also prepare scientists and scientific-researchers (candidates and doctors of sciences);
- constitute a scientific and methodological center in different fields.

2. The Academies, which:

- implement programmes of higher education, under-graduate and postgraduate in its field of scientific activity;
- carry out fundamental and applied research on a wide range of issues;
- prepare, train, retrain and ensure professional development, and also prepare scientists and scientific-researchers (candidates and doctors of sciences);

3. The Institutes are the structural subdivisions of the University or Academy, which:

- implement programmes of higher education and educational programmes for undergraduates;
- prepare, train, retrain, and ensure professional development of workers with higher education;
- prepare scientific and scientific-research pedagogical personnel for certain sphere of professional activity;
- carry out some fundamental and applied researches of fundamental and applied character, according to the specialists' prepared profile.

4. The Specialized Institutes (conservatories, specific purpose institutes), which:

- implement programmes of higher and postgraduate education;
- prepare, train, retrain, ensure professional development, and also prepare scientific and scientific-research pedagogical personnel for certain sphere of professional activity;
- carry out applied scientific researches.

8.2 Educational and Professional Programmes and Awarded Qualifications

Higher education institutions of the Kyrgyz Republic conduct education according to the following academic programmes:

- Bachelor's Degree: 4 years. In order to be graduated, students must fulfill a set of course requirements and complete 240 ECTS, pass the final state examination and defend Bachelor's Thesis.

- Master's Degree: 2 years. In order to be graduated, students must fulfill a set of course requirements and complete 120 ECTS, pass the final state examination and defend Master's Thesis.

- Specialist's Degree (Qualifications provided by Specialist's Degree are equal to that of Master's Degree): 5 years. In order to be graduated, students must fulfill a set of course requirements, pass the final state examination and defend a Diploma Thesis.

- Post Graduate Degree (Kandidat Nauk) (Aspirantura): 3 years. No courses are required, a research project is conducted and research papers are published in defined journals. A Kandidat Nauk Thesis is prepared and defended to be graduated.

- Doctor of Science Degree (Equal to Habilitation practiced in some European countries). This degree is conferred upon fulfillment of a research project at Doktorantura (3 years) and successful defense of a thesis before an academic committee. The Doctor of Science Degree allows obtaining a professorship.

8.3 License and Attestation of the Educational Professional Programmes

Higher education institutions obtain license of Ministry of Education and Science of the Kyrgyz Republic to implement educational programmes of different levels. Once in five years higher education institutions pass the state attestation (accreditation), which is held by the State Inspection on Licensing and Attestation of educational Institutions.

8.4 General Structure of the Kyrgyz Education System
